If a conflict exists with a World Languages exam, the World Languages exam must be taken first. Teachers will arrange to leave all exams in the library in an envelope with the date, session, student's name, name of subject, and the teacher's name printed clearly on the envelope. For exam security reasons, exams are not to be left in teacher mailboxes. Completed exams will be left by the proctors in the library and should be picked up by each individual teacher.
